

ROBERT W. FURNAS MEMORIAL AWARD

The **Robert W. Furnas Memorial Award**, created in 1991, recognizes "outstanding contributions or assistance to the Nebraska State Historical Society," in the form of either long-term service or a significant one-time contribution by an individual or organization. A committee drawn from the current NSHS Board of Trustees, the Emeritus Trustees, and the NSHS staff nominates/selects the recipient. The award consists of a plaque and a lifetime membership with the Nebraska State Historical Society.
