

## JAMES L. SELLERS MEMORIAL AWARD

The **James L. Sellers Memorial Award** was created in 1967. The award consists of a plaque and a lifetime membership with the Nebraska State Historical Society, is given each year for the "best article" published in a volume of *Nebraska History*. The author receives a plaque and \$1,000 from the NSHS Foundation, through the support of Catherine Sellers Angle. Judges (usually three) are provided by a Nebraska college or university history department that is not represented by an article in the judging pool. The judges are solicited by the editor of *Nebraska History*. Articles are evaluated on use of primary sources, quality of research and writing, and reader interest. The Society staff and members of the executive board are eligible to receive the Sellers Award and have received it.
